1. RULES FOR THE CANDIDATES.

1.1 Only the students whose names appear in the Electoral Roll shall stand as candidate for the portfolios/ office bearer.

1.2 A Candidate shall file **NOMINATION FOR ONLY ONE PORTFOLIO.**

1.3 A Candidate may file **AS MANY AS FIVE NOMINATION PAPERS** for the same post each with different proposer and supporter.

1.4 A Candidate shall strictly follow the instructions given in the Nomination paper, while filling up the paper. For any incorrect entry/ overwriting or violation of instruction may lead to rejection of Nomination papers. The papers shall be thoroughly examined by a competent Scrutiny Board, and the verdict of the Scrutiny Board shall be final.

1.5 A candidate shall submit her Nomination papers personally to the Returning Officer SHOWING HER COLLEGE IDENTITY CARD/ADMISSION MONEY RECEIPT OF THE CURRENT SESSION AND NOT THROUGH HER AGENT.

1.6 If a candidate wants to withdraw her Nomination paper, she shall withdraw her Nomination personally from the Returning Officer and not through her proposer/supporter or authorized agent, on the date and time fixed for withdrawal.

1.7 Either the candidate herself and/ or her authorized agent totaling in two persons maximum may be present inside the **Polling Booth/ Counting Office, during polling/counting hours.**

1.8 The authorized agent of the candidate must be from among the electorate. Their authority letter of agent-ship must be duly signed by the candidate concerned and certified by the Returning Officer.

1.9 The authorized agents of the candidates must carry and ever-ready to produce her College **IDENTY CARD/ADMISSION MONEY RECEIPT OF THE CURRENT SESSION** and the authority letter of the agent-ship, whenever asked by the Returning Officer/Presiding Officer/Chief Counting Officer/Polling Officer/Counting Officer.

1.10 The electoral roll shall be available in the office of the undersigned and only one copy of electoral roll shall be supplied on request to the contestant after the publication of the final list of the candidates on payment of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand).

1.11 A Candidate shall stop all kinds of public canvassing in favour of her candidature within the college Campus once the platform speech is over.

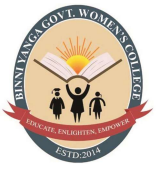
1.12 A CANDIDATE SHALL SEE THAT NO HANDBILL OR POSTER OR WRITING IS INSCRIBED ON THE WALLS OF THE COLLEGE BUILDING IN ORDER TO CANVASS IN FAVOUR OF HER WHICH MAY LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION OF HER CANDIDATURE.

A Candidate shall not bring any agent or person other than the bonafide electorate in the college premises in order to help her in the election campaign.

II RULES FOR PROPOSERS AND SUPPORTERS:-

2.1 The students whose names have appeared in the Electoral Roll only shall propose and/or Support candidates for portfolios in their nomination papers.

2.2 A candidate shall not propose or support a candidate for the portfolio for which herself is a candidate.



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- 2.3 The same student shall not be both propose and support a candidate for the same portfolio.
- 2.4 A proposer/supporter shall not propose or support more than one candidate for the same portfolio.
- 2.5 The proposers/supporters of candidates shall strictly follow the instruction given for them in the respective columns of the Nomination paper.

III GENERAL RULES FOR THE ELECTORATE:

- 3.1 Only the bonafide students enrolled for the academic session 2024-2025 of this college shall have the right to vote.
- 3.2 **EACH VOTER SHALL KEEP WITH HER THE COLLEGE IDENTITY CARD/ADMISSION MONEY RECEIPT OF THE CURRENT SESSION WHILE GOING TO EXERCISE HER FRANCHISE WHICH SHE SHALL PRODUCE IN CASE ASKED FOR BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER.**
- 3.3 All the members of the electorate shall see that a congenial atmosphere is maintained for the conduct of a free and fair election.
- 3.4 In view of the letter received from the Government, there is provision of NOTA (None of the Above) in the ballot paper. In case an electorate does not prefer to cast her vote in favour of any contesting candidate against ant port-folio, she can opt for NOTA provision while putting voting mark seal in the relevant column of NOTA.

However, in case if the candidate is putting a voting mark seal in favour of any candidate against any portfolio as well as voting mark seal in the NOTA coloum for the same portfolio, it will be treated invalid.

IV RULES FOR BALLOT:

- 4.1 In the Ballot papers names of the candidates shall be printed in alphabetical order.
